- iii Stewardship Days: These are days in a quarter designed to promote Stewardship.
- iv Women Strategy: Stewardship Lessons designed to promote Stewardship
- v Testimony Power: Number of Testimonies presented.
- vi Berean Principle: Number of families studying Stewardship books systematically.
- vii A Guardian is a faithful steward who is entrusted with a new or old member who needs encouragement in stewardship.

**NOTE:** In case where one parent has a spouse and 3 children who are baptized and these return a family tithe and offering, the number should read 5.
